Part of the HS Timber Group since 2010, **HS Baco Panels** is located in Comanesti, Romania, in a region with history and tradition in woodworking. After successive investments, the plant almost doubled its workforce and tripled its production capacity by the end of 2014.

The factory processes softwood timber that could not be put to superior use and turns it into blockboards and shuttering panels, excellent materials for the furniture industry, interior design, and constructions.

Unique security architecture: GPS tracking system Timflow

HS Timber Productions only purchases wood from 100% secure sources. We use the Timflow GPS system in Romania, which monitors each saw log truck's exact transport route, from the loading point to the mill gate. This is a voluntary system, surpassing all legal requirements by far. All collected data, including full GPS maps of the route and photos of the loaded trucks before departure, is public on www.timflow.com.
