Unique security architecture: GPS tracking system Timflow

HS Timber Group is committed to only purchase wood from traceable sources. In Romania, we use the GPS tracking system, Timflow, which monitors each saw log truck's exact transport route, from the loading point to the mill gate. This is a voluntary system, surpassing all legal requirements by far. All collected data, including full GPS maps of the route and photos of the loaded trucks, is public on www.timflow.com.
