Construction of a biomass cogeneration plant

HS Timber Productions is investing € 24 million in the construction of a state-of-the-art biomass cogeneration plant (heat and power). The plant will power all production processes within the sawmill, excess electricity will be fed into the grid, thus supplying private households with sustainable, green energy. The biomass cogeneration plant is scheduled to go into operation in 2020.
