The Radauti sawmill is the second production unit built by **HS Timber Productions** in Romania, in 2008. The beam production line is the most modern in Romania and was specially designed for the Japanese market. The sawmill processes 100% of the raw material and is self-sufficient, as it produces all the electric and thermal energy needed—the biomass power plant is the largest in the country.

Unique security architecture: GPS tracking system Timflow

HS Timber Productions only purchases wood from 100% secure sources. We use the Timflow GPS system in Romania, which monitors each saw log truck’s exact transport route, from the loading point to the mill gate. This is a voluntary system, surpassing all legal requirements by far. All collected data, including full GPS maps of the route and photos of the loaded trucks before departure, is public on www.timflow.com.

CSR at a glance: Tomorrow’s Forest
