Update Holzindustrie Schweighofer: Eighth EUTR control with positive results

At the end of March 2017, Holzindustrie Schweighofer's sawmill in Sebes was subject to another control in accordance with the European Timber Regulation (EUTR). Just as the recent inspection in Radauti, which was also carried out in the same month, the competent authorities confirmed the correctness of the company's due diligence system. The control in Sebes already marked the eighth EUTR-control of Holzindustrie Schweighofer's Romanian plants – all of which rendered positive results.

For Holzindustrie Schweighofer, this positive result represents a clear indication for the effectiveness of its action plan to ensure a sustainable timber supply chain in Romania. The aim of the measures that are currently being rolled out is to effectively fight illegal logging in Romania. Holzindustrie Schweighofer assumes this responsibility despite the fact that the company does not harvest any trees itself.

The "European Timber Regulation" is the legal framework ensuring that only legally harvested timber enters the European Union's market. The core of the stipulated due diligence system is that operators undertake a risk management exercise so as to minimize the risk of placing illegally harvested timber, or timber products containing illegally harvested timber, on the EU market.

During these controls, Holzindustrie Schweighofer's due diligence systems were examined in terms of effectiveness and correctness. In all of the cases, the competent authorities confirmed that Holzindustrie Schweighofer's due diligence system complied with the EUTR and Romania's respective laws and regulations.

The EUTR controls took place at the following sites: Radauti (March and August 2015, March 2017), Sebes (March 2016, March 2017), Comanesti (November and December 2016), Reci (November 2016).
