



Since 2018, HS Timber Group has voluntarily disclosed sustainability efforts, ensuring transparency, ethical business conduct, and sustainable operations.

Our business is built around a simple idea: using every part of the wood we source responsibly. Wood is a renewable resource, and we take pride in making the most of it by turning every piece into valuable products - from sawn timber to bioenergy made of wood by-products. This "full use" approach is key to what we do, helping us minimize waste, lowering our carbon footprint, and contributing to a healthier planet.

The 2023 Sustainability Report of HS Timber Group highlights the company's commitment to environmental stewardship, responsible governance, and social impact. The report is aligned with the European Sustainability Reporting Standards (ESRS) and anticipates compliance with new EU regulations, such as the Corporate Sustainability Reporting Directive (CSRD) and the EU Deforestation Regulation (EUDR).

The following pages summarize the key facts and achievements.



In HS Timber Group we have established ambitious goals in addressing climate change. Our focus areas are on renewable energy, optimizing the waste cycle, and continuously improving our measures to reduce emissions and environmental impact. HS Timber Group is committed to environmental protection through the implementation of an Environmental Management System (EMS) that promotes recycling, energy efficiency, and sustainable resource use.

We have implemented a range of technical and organizational measures at various levels to reach our goals. Our decarbonization strategy focuses on several key levers: transitioning from fossil fuels to fossil-free energy, electrification of our vehicles and forklifts, expanding renewable energy production e.g. by installing large-scale photovoltaic plants and by implementing energy efficiency measures.

## **Green Energy and Renewable Sources**


- + 90% of total energy consumption comes from renewable sources

By responsibly using wood we aim to support and become an integral part of a circular economy. HS Timber Group's targets are closely related to several key aspects of resource inflows and outflows, specifically focusing on the efficient use and sustainable sourcing of raw materials.






